

## **NYC: Summer Art Gallery Internship | HOA 400**

Are you looking for real world experience in the business of art? Then look no further. HOA 400 is a new art-gallery internship-based course that will be offered in summer 2018 in NYC. Internships will include in-depth projects and day-to-day operational tasks. Weekly classes will include guest lectures and panel discussions during which students will interface with leaders in the art world as well as with designers, artists and art advisors. Students will be accepted into this course *only after* they have (a) submitted a statement of purpose + resume, and (b) conducted interviews with the course instructor by telephone or skype/facetime. To be considered for this course, you must **apply by April 13**. Your statement of purpose should outline *why* you wish to take this course and *what* you expect to learn from it.
